FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ)

Q: What length should I get?

A: We recommend eight (8') foot for an average six (6') foot body frame who wants to make two small cross-steps to get to the tip. You can either go taller or shorter by the quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$  ") inch. Nonetheless, we make any length and proportion the widths according to the Ugly template.

Q: What width should I get?

A: The Super Ugly is based on the classic Ugly shape and has a width of approximately twenty two inches (22") to twenty four inches (23"), depending on the length. The width is proportioned to the length and follows the unique Ugly template. The tip and tail are also proportioned to the width and the length to maintain the Ugly shape.

Q: What rails should I get?

A: You have to know a bit about the effects of the way the rail is turned to know exactly what you need to progress with the tricks you're working on. The choices take some experience in advanced surfing and board knowledge to make up your own scheme. If you would like to discuss this aspect, please feel free to contact us and we would be happy to help you decide. Choices include, turned down or turned up by percentage (%) in the tail, Center and tip and can be more specific. If you wish us to help you make the proper choice for you, it would be our pleasure after we discuss your experience and what you want to achieve next.

Q: What thickness should I get for my weight?

A: Weight and thickness do correlate, and so does experience and the way the rails are turned. Let us know your experience and we'll make it the right thickness for your capabilities. Write us a little note and describe your best ride and what you did on the board, with the wave – more detail is better than less.

Q: What stringers can I get?

A. There are Cedar  $\frac{1}{4}$ " wood stringers that sandwich a foam spreader, which spreads apart as it graduates to the tip. The center foam can be air sprayed any color. The stringer that spreads enables us to get the wide 20" nose that the Ugly is known for. This stringer is the standard that is included in the base price. We can discuss any special changes you might want.

Q: What cloth is available?

A: Included in the base price of the standard Super Ugly is 8 and 6-ounce (oz) fiberglass layers on top with a 8 oz fiberglass bottom. Volan (green) fiberglass is used exclusively on The Ugly SE. You may also choose to use exotic materials, such as "S" cloth, Kevlar, Graphite weaves, or even Borron. These are special orders and prices vary. Fabric inlays are \$60 per side and you provide the fabric. Extra layer of glass is \$40. There are a few other options available, so please don't hesitate to call for a quote.

Q: What kind of finish can I have, polished or sanded?

A: Either comes included. Polished makes the board ride a tad faster and sanded makes the board a lot lighter.

Q: Can I provide my own graphics and how much will it cost?

A. We would appreciate a sketch to be precise and color choices made by Pantone numbers. Our prices are reasonable and our artists are some of the best. We dare you to challenge us! Pin lines are \$40 and call for a quote on airbrushing, and/or your art transfer.

Q: How do I describe my color choice?

A: Use Pantone numbered colors preferrably or send us a swatch of the color and we will match it.

Q: Should I get a glassed on fin or a fin-box?

A: A fin-box comes included. We recommend it for traveling purposes. Glassed on fins and fins are extra. Please ask for a quote at the time of ordering.

Q: Do I need a tail and nose block?

A: Nose blocks and tail blocks protect the tip ad tail from severe damage. They were invented in the 60's when we didn't have leashes. Because they were made out of material that is much more dense than foam, they could withstand greater impact. Materials used include, high density foam, wood and laminated wood. Please call for a quote.
